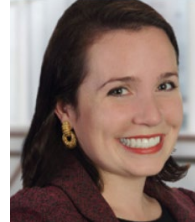

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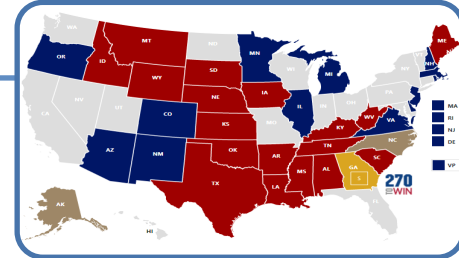
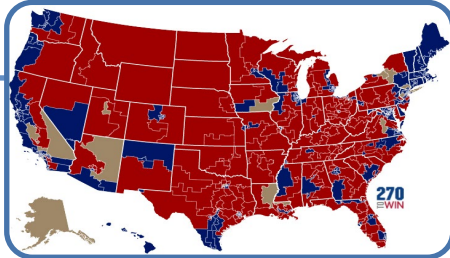

Control of the Senate will likely be determined by two runoff elections in Georgia on Jan. 5.

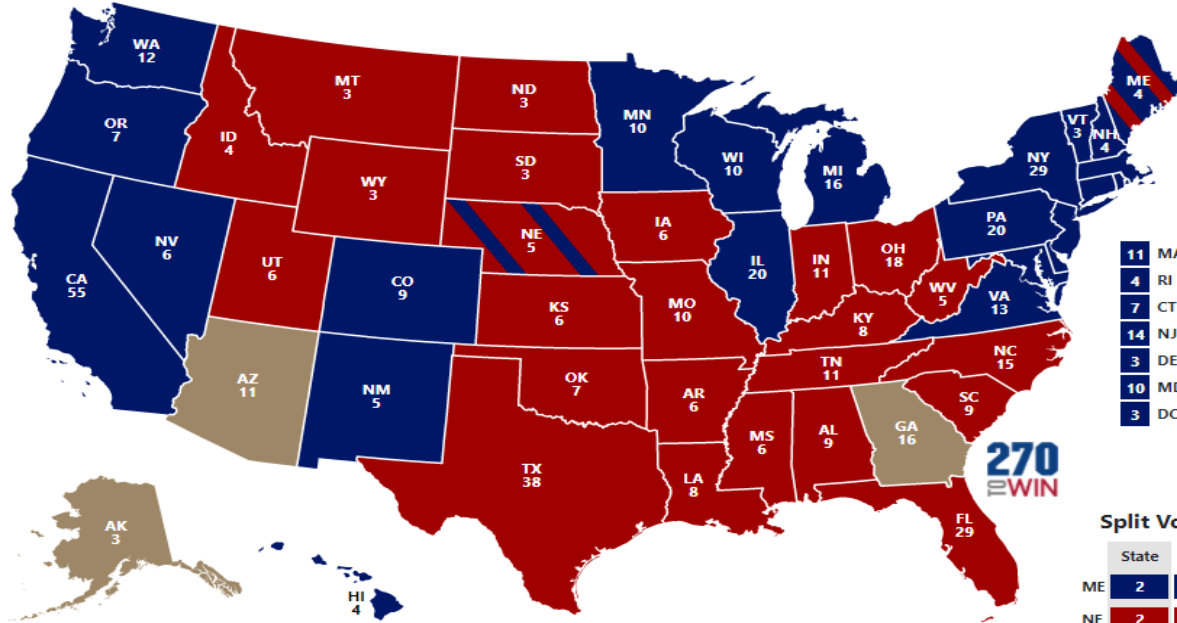
# 2020 Electoral College

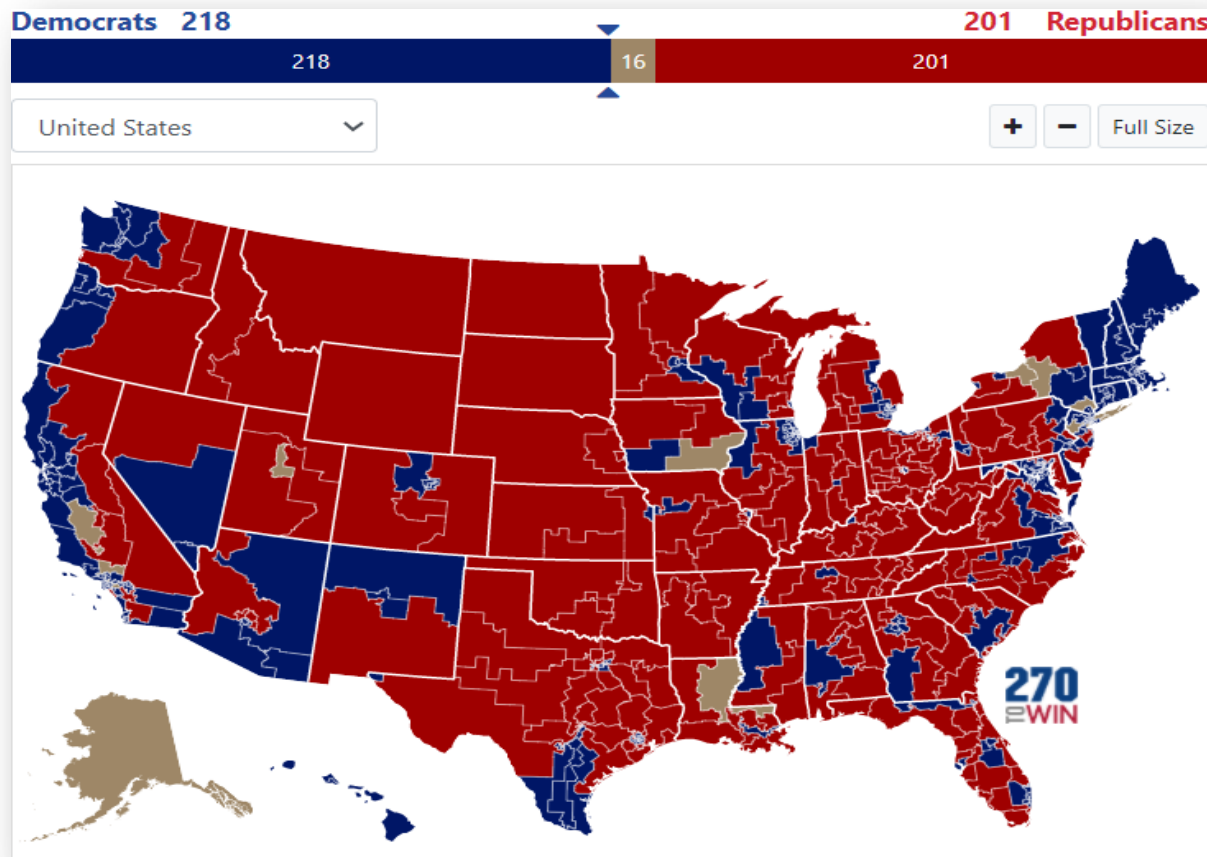

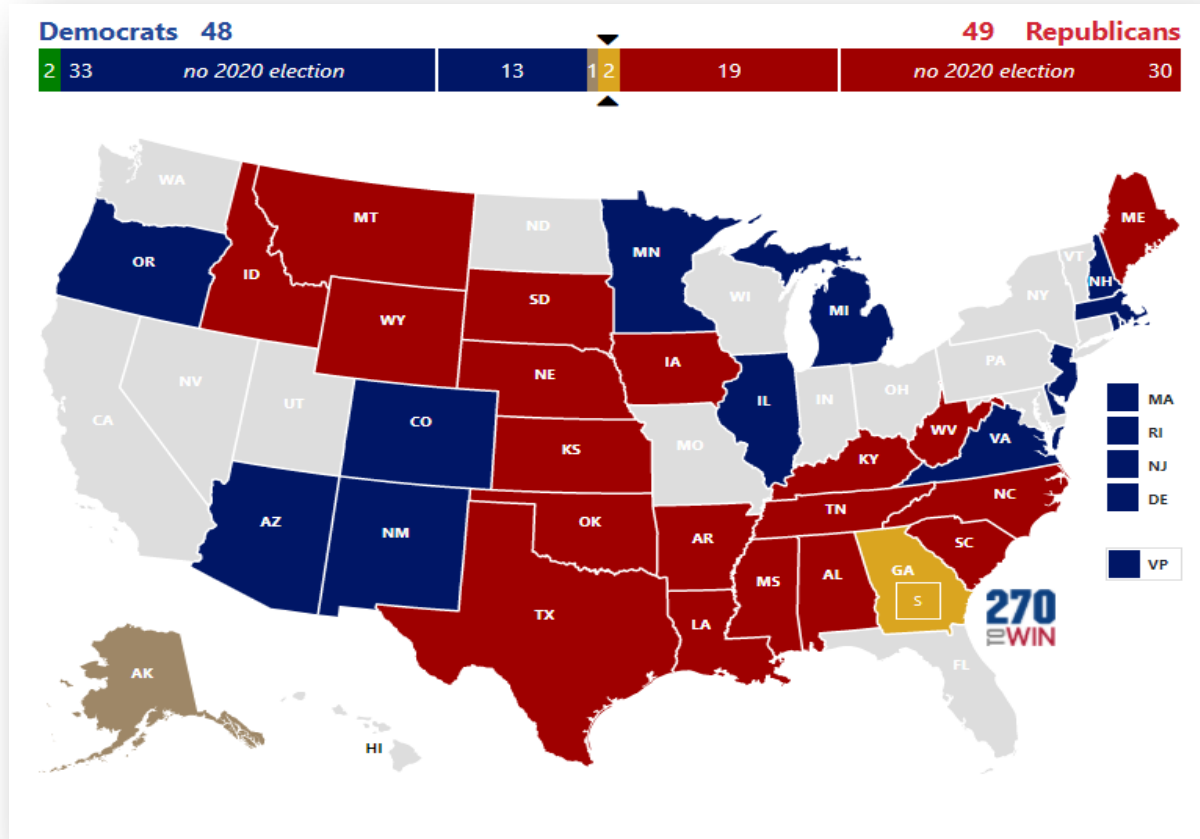

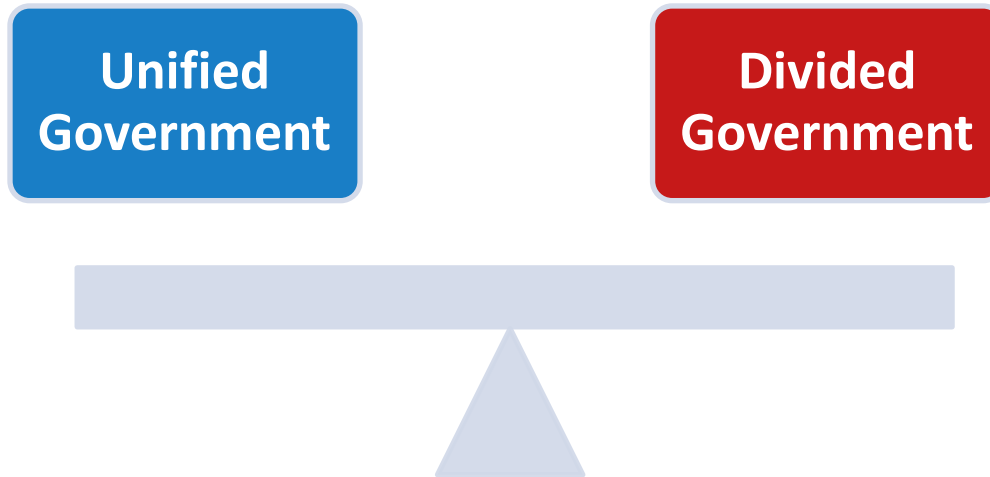

- FY2021 Appropriations Expire – Dec. 11
- Electoral College meets to cast ballots – Dec. 14
- Beginning of 117th Congress – Jan. 3, 2021
- Georgia Senate Runoff Elections – Jan. 5, 2021
- Inauguration Day – Jan. 20, 2021
